FSC also audit us for Core Labour requirements, ensuring we perform duties ethically in terms of employment, antislavery, child labour, and equal opportunities for our workforce and suppliers.

Pathway to New Zero

The Paris Agreement

RH Fibreboard are aligning our pathway to net zero with the Paris Agreement, which sets out a global framework to avoid dangerous climate change by limiting global warming to well below 2 degrees Celsius at 1.5 degrees Celsius. The Paris agreement has been signed and agreed by most countries/world leaders and is a legally binding international treaty signed in 2016.

To ensure the 1.5-degree target is hit, means a commitment for businesses to become net zero by 2050, and to reduce emissions by 45%, by the year 2030.

These will be our published targets and will likely be based on measurable Science based targets (SBTi's), such as carbon emission reduction, until (or unless) policy or legislation brings change to the measurement system.

Short Term Targets, 2023-2025

- Implement ISO9001, and a qualified Environmental Management System under the audited process of ISO14001.
- Procure a Green/Environmental/Sustainability Partner to further qualify, design and support the Pathway to net Zero going forward.
- Determine our Carbon Footprint
- Further reduce and change our consumption of fossil fuels, water and other resources that impact the environment and begin to measure the change using SBTi.

- Continue to promote Circular Economy activities limiting the use of plastics, minerals and products that have poor recycling rates and reuse and recycle where possible.
- Actively look for Carbon footprint saving projects.
- Implement plans for using energy from Sustainable and renewable resources such as Solar

Medium Term Targets, 2025-2030

- Achieve 45% emission reduction by 2030.
- Measure and report indirect as well as direct emissions (Scope 2 and 3)
- Implement further energy sources from renewable resources across production activities and fleet.

Long Term Targets,

Achieve Net Zero by 2050
